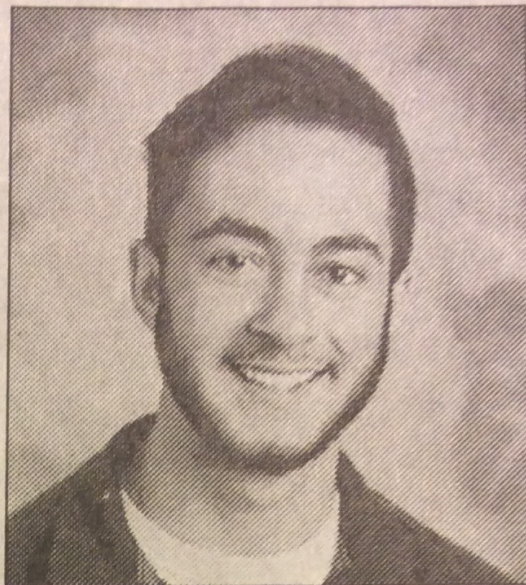


# Student of the Week
