

## **Long-Term Effects of Technology**

**H**uman activities are affecting the environment in ways we do not yet understand because a generation of human lives is too short a time for us to determine:

- the effects on the atmosphere of carbon dioxide from automobiles, power plants, and factories (the greenhouse effect).
- the possible genetic effects of **radiation** from the burning of coal and from the use of nuclear power plants.

- the long-term effects of **birth control** on populations.
- the long-term consequences of our destruction of plant and animal species and our worldwide destruction of forests.
